Bordailles Blanc™† Crisp and delicate on the palate, this wine boasts a faintly herbaceous flavour.	3 3 0
Chamblaise™ A blend of a variety of grapes, this full-flavoured wine is smooth, clean and well balanced.	1 2 0
Chardonnay A full-bodied wine with crisp, green apple bouquet and hearty flavour.	4 4 0
Chenin Blanc† Chenin Blanc has a dominant flavour; slightly fruity and unique in many ways. You'll savour apple and honey flavours.	0 2 0
French Colombar Crisp, acidic and extremely fragrant in its youth. A lovely summer refresher.	2 2 0

Barolo Deep in colour; high in tannin, full-bodied and robust this wine is intense on the palate.	2 4 0
Bergamais™ A fresh wine best consumed in its youth. Cherries and plums fill the nose while sweet cherry follows through to the palate, where it lingers gracefully.	0 3 0
Cabernet Sauvignon Considered the noblest of all grapes, this full-bodied red is dark in colour and aggressive in nature. A hint of violet is present in the bouquet, typical of this variety. It's superbly enhanced with the addition of oak, and does well with age.	3 4 0
Chat Dormant™† A dark, rich, full-bodied wine so smooth it's like liquid velvet. Hints of plum and licorice in the bouquet lead to dry, intense flavours of raspberry and strawberry on the palate.	1 4 0
Chianti Aggressive in nature, it is crisp, clean and spicy with a subtle black pepper flavour. A perfect match with Italian food.	2 3 0
Malbec This rustic red wine has a soft, rich texture, silky tannins, and fills your palate with ripe plums, currants, cherries and red berries.	4 3 0
Merlot A smooth, rich wine, medium dark in colour, with notes of blackberry and currants. A hint of green olive in the bouquet will pleasantly surprise you.	4 4 0
Petite Syrah This rich, extremely dark wine has notes of plum that will entice you. It's high tannins will allow this wine to age gracefully.	3 3 0
★ Pinot Noir A rich red wine, hearty in nature and smooth in flavour. The soft texture and dark colour complement the flavours of berry fruit, with a subtle raspberry undertone.	3 4 0
Valpolicella An intense, deep-coloured red wine boasting a velvety yet fruity flavour, with a long, lingering finish. Aging will only add to the complexity of this wine.	3 3 0
